DAISY Award honorees consistently demonstrate excellence through their clinical expertise and extraordinary compassionate care. They are recognized as outstanding role models in our nursing community

What is The DAISY Award?

The DAISY Award is an international program that rewards and celebrates the extraordinary compassionate and skillful care given by nurses every day. Invest in Kids is proud to be a DAISY Award Partner, recognizing one of our nurses and teams with this special honor twice yearly.

The DAISY Award Nominee

Each DAISY Award Nominee must be a NFP Nurse, or team including an NFP Nurse currently employed by NFP and every nominee will receive a nomination pin.

The DAISY Award Honoree

The DAISY Award Honoree will receive a beautiful certificate, a DAISY Award pin, and a hand-carved stone sculpture entitled A Healer's Touch. Teams will receive a plaque with team members names engraved.

Nomination forms must be filled out completely and must include a written description of a specific situation in which the nurse or team demonstrated one or more of these principles **(by going above and beyond daily expectations)**

Exemplary Care

Provides exemplary client-centered care with fidelity to the NFP model using evidence-based practice in a therapeutic environment.

Leadership and Innovation

Displays autonomous and/or collaborative clinical judgment, takes initiative, and participates in quality improvement, and promotes achievement of site goals in optimizing client care.

Professionalism

Serves as a role model for the profession of nursing, values personal and professional growth, and strives for exemplary professional practice.

DAISY Honoree Selection Process

1. All Nurse-Home Visitor or Team nomination forms will be received by an Invest in Kids staff member outside of the DAISY Award Committee.
2. Nominations will be blinded and reviewed by the IIK DAISY Award Committee and one individual and one team DAISY Honoree will be chosen.
3. The Honoree's agency will be notified and will work with IIK to plan an award celebration.
4. All nominees not chosen will receive their nomination pin by mail.
5. All nominations not chosen will be evaluated in each bi-annual award cycle for one year following their nomination.
6. Awards will be announced the first week of May and November.

Frequently Asked Questions

Does the scenario described in the nomination form need to be recent? Yes, all nomination forms must include information, situations, or examples that have occurred within the previous year.

Who can fill out a nomination form? Any employee of Nurse-Family Partnership within your agency or a community partner may fill out a nomination form.

When are nominations due? Nominations are to be turned in by April 1st and October 1st.

When will winners be announced? Winners will be announced sometime during the first week of May and November.

Can someone win the award twice? Yes, a nurse will be eligible to win the award again after a year has passed.

How many awards are there? There is an individual nurse leader award and team award. There will be one winner chosen for each category twice yearly.

Daisy Nurse Leader Award

The Nurse Leader Award honors any NFP Nurse, currently practicing, who creates an environment where compassionate, skillful care thrives.

The Nurse Leader Award will be awarded twice yearly and will be evaluated separately from the team award.

Team Award

The DAISY Team Award is designed to honor collaboration by two or more people, including an NFP Nurse, who identify and meet client needs by going above and beyond the traditional role of nursing.

The DAISY Team Award can be given twice yearly and will be evaluated separately from the nurse leader award.
